Performance as Education Conduct Guidelines and Policies

1. Inappropriate or offensive behavior, including harassment of others, or threats to harm oneself or others, is prohibited. Willful damage to property will not be tolerated. Participants are responsible for the cost of any damages that they incur. Any violations will be reported law enforcement.
2. Use of alcohol, tobacco and/or non-prescribed drugs and/or misuse of prescribed drugs or weapons of any kind will result in an immediate dismissal from the program. Police and parent/guardian will be notified of the infraction; and will assume responsibility for immediately retrieving their child.
3. Students under age 18 must have a signed permission slip from a parent/guardian for use of prescription medication.
4. Staff will provide a daily itinerary for activities. Participants are expected to attend all activity as directed by staff. If a participant will have difficulty attending, they **must** speak to program staff **prior** to the event. Participants are expected to plan ahead and stay on schedule.
5. **Participants are expected to be punctual and enthusiastically participate** in each scheduled event. All participants must be respectful of the staff, chaperones, speakers, and supervisors throughout the program.
6. All electronic devices **must be turned off** during programs.
7. While staying in a dorm or hotel room, participants are not permitted to leave areas designated for activities at any time unless accompanied by a staff member.
8. Participants are not allowed on the floor or in the room of a member of the opposite sex. All inter-gender socializing will be monitored by camp staff.
9. Keep dorm rooms locked at all times. Do NOT bring TVs, computer games, X-Boxes, portable DVDs, or other valuable items. WSU is not responsible for stolen or lost items. Participants are responsible for their room keys and will be billed \$60.00 for each key not returned.
10. Keep dorm rooms and common hall areas clean. All rooms will be inspected prior to checking out.
11. Participants must comply with curfew hours. Room checks will be held each night after lights out. Students are not allowed to leave their assigned room after room check. Violation of curfew hours may result in dismissal from the program.
12. During their period of participation in Performance as Education, students may **not** receive visitors. Do not let anyone into the residence hall unless they are attending the program with you.

13. Participants will dress modestly and appropriately at all times. Please do not wear any clothing that is midriff-baring or allows others to view undergarments. Those dressed inappropriately will be required to change.
14. Participants who use the Student Recreation Center (SRC) must comply with all SRC rules. Swim suits must be worn in the pool (no shorts or cutoffs). Open toed shoes are not allowed at the SRC.
15. Address any issues or concerns with a staff member.
16. Agree to follow all program and WSU policies.
17. Have Fun. Make friends. Be ready to make suggestion that will improve the program.
